**Entries:** Postal entries close on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June.  
Online entries open on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June and close at 15:00 on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July.

**Qualification:** There is no specific qualification criteria for this event.

**Format:**

A qualifying competition will be held in the morning for each championship class. This will take the form of a two round competition (Article 238) (Optimum time for Primary and Advanced Primary riders).

Up to 20 riders from each grade from the morning qualifier will go forward to the championship final. Additional places may be allocated in the final on the grounds of equality of penalties.

**Competitors:**

Only registered members of the Association of Irish Riding Clubs at the close of entries are eligible to enter this event.

Competitors may only compete at their show jumping grade at the time of entering, irrespective of any subsequent grade changes.

It is the competitors' responsibility to be fully conversant with the rules for this competition.

**Horses:**

Horses must be entered under their registered name as described on their passport, at this event. Consult rule 6 in the rules and regulations (D04/12) of the Association for eligibility criteria.

If your horse is not registered with the Association, you will not be able to enter online. For information on registering a horse, [click here](#). Please ensure to register your horse in time before entering this event.

You can check to see if your horse is already registered by logging into your [membership online](#) account or alternatively by searching for it, using its registered name, [here](#).

**Postal Entries:**

Postal entries are accepted through your club secretary on the official entry form to arrive no later than **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June**.

To enter this event, please provide your club secretary with your name, your membership number, your horses registered name and the competitions you are entering.

Incomplete or late postal entries will be not be processed and will be returned to your club secretary.

**Online Entries:**

Online entries are accepted through the membership online service from **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June until 15:00 on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July**. Never used this service before? [read this](#).

If you are unfamiliar with using the membership online service, it is recommended that you enter via your club secretary using the postal entry system.

**Entry Fees & Information:**

- €20 per championship qualifier entry
- €15 per other entry

Hors concours and novice horse entries are not accepted at this event nor are late entries.

**Refunds:**

Full refunds will be issued for withdrawals received, in writing using the event refund request form (F14/11), by the close of entries. No refund will be issued for withdrawals received after this date.

In the event of this championship being abandoned (i.e. after it started), for whatever reason, no refunds will be issued.

**Volunteers:**

Each region will be allocated tasks to assist with the running of this event and therefore all participating members will be called upon by your club/region to volunteer at this event.
